

## Oh the Zoo!

Make some paper animals.

The paper animals should be able to stand on their own. You can also use your own small toy animals.



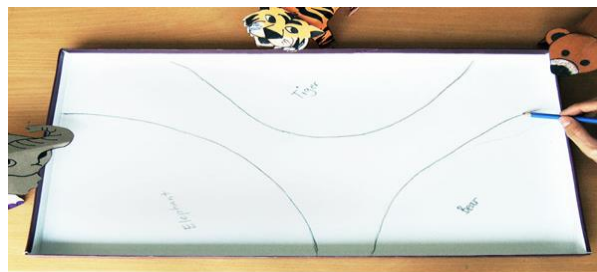
**Prepare a box.**

Find a box for your zoo such as a pizza box, large shoe box, or laptop box. You can glue several boxes together for an extra large zoo.



**Make a layout.**

Draw an outline of your plan on the box.



**Cover the ground clay.**

Cover the area inside the box with clay or play dough. Choose the color of the clay or dough depending on the habitat that the animal in—green for a grassy ground, brown for a dry or desert habitat, and white for a snowy cover. You can also colour it.



### **Create a watering hole.**

You can make a watering hole with blue clay. You can also color it.



### **Make a fence.**

Create a fence around each area using wooden or plastic ice cream spoons, craft sticks cut in half, drinking straws, or construction paper cut into 1-inch wide strips. Push each one deep into the dough or glue it on.



### **Add plants.**

Make plants using green feathers, paper or any material you would like. Stick them into the clay/playdough or glue them in.
